

Updates from the Business Office (Miss Savannah Grosch)

For the 2024-2025 school year, Erie Day School is excited to announce we will be upgrading and updating SchoolSpeak and Blackbaud Tuition Management. Through the parent company of Community Brands, we are using TADS and EDUCATE! TADS will be the new tuition management system and EDUCATE the new student/class management system. There are a couple of steps that you as the parent/guardian need to complete to make this transition happen.


1. **TO SET UP TADS**: All parents should have an email like the screen shot on the next page from support@tads.com, or sgrosch@eriedayschool.com. The link provided in the email is specific to your family; please do not share! Following the opening of the link, you will be brought to the sign in screen where each parent can create a new account. From there, you will agree to electronic FORMS and SIGNATURES.

Then you will select the payment plan desired for the 24-25 tuition and add payment method. Payment options include automatic credit card payments, automatic bank payments or a monthly invoice. Once selected, you will agree to the Tuition Agreement and Terms. This is similar to the paper copy you signed back in Jan./Feb. TADS will be used for tuition, extended day payments, sports fees, performing arts fees, tax information, etc..



2. **UPDATING ENROLLMENT FORMS:** The second step in our transition will be to update any enrollment forms and information. After creating your billing agreement, you will select *ENROLLMENT* on the left hand side. Click on the enrollment number to

enter your students account. Push the "Click here to edit student's enrollment information". From there, click through each tab (e.g. Student, Household, Grandparents, Contacts, etc.) to update any information. There is an edit button under each of those sections. (This information replaces the paper forms required at the beginning of each school year.) See visual on the next page.



TO SET UP EDUCATE: The third and final step in your new online management tool is to set up your Educate account. Follow these steps outlined though the following hyperlink: Educate Household Portal for Parents
